Emery Neal commented he feels that Chief Jacqueline Seabrooks is a good chief and the City Council made a good selection in selecting her for the job.

There being no further business to be presented, Mayor Dorn declared the meeting adjourned in honor of Edmund “Baby” Burns, Carl Brannon and Kevin Wickes at the hour of 11:58 a.m.
