PUBLIC HEARING HELD – INGLEWOOD HOUSING AUTHORITY’S ANNUAL PLAN FY 2010-2011. Staff report dated May 25, 2010 was presented to consider the approval of the Inglewood Housing Authority’s Annual Plan FY 2010-2011.

Sheldon Curry, Acting City Administrator, presented the staff report dated May 25, 2010.

Chairman Pro Tempore Tabor received and filed the staff report.

Kathryn Epps, HUD Program Manager gave a brief oral report.

Chairman Pro Tempore Tabor inquired if there were any persons present who wish to address the City Council on this matter.

Diane Sambrano commented the program should be about the number of people assisted and not about the services.

Bill Widner made the inquiry, how do the tenants get the information. He commented the City of Inglewood does not comply with federal regulations.

Gil Mathieu commented the Housing Department needs an oversight process, and he opposes supporting the Annual Plan.

Mike Stevens commented the City should use every option to turn low income housing to affordable housing after time limits have been reached.

Leroy Fisher commented the presentation tonight was not good, and not where the residents can understand.

Willie Agee commented on the homeless in the City of Inglewood.

Chairman Pro Tempore Tabor closed the public comment portion at the hour of 9:56 p.m.
